





supporting students' group work and **project-based teaching** in elementary school, middle school, or high school



REQUIREMENTS:

English language;
Italian Language
(preferable).



ENROLEMENT:



- Expressing interest at your **Sending Organisation** and applying for the EU funded scholarship (Erasmus+).
- Choosing between: **3, 6, or 9 months long traineeship.**
- Connecting with a **Local Coordinator in Italy.**
- Prior to their arrival the trainees will be provided with a **time-table.**
- A **final report** is sent to the **Sending Organisation** upon the completion of the traineeship.
