Project goal: The "Adriana" project represents a contribution to the research of the phenomenon of maritimeness of Croatian culture in the field of narrative literature, both fictional and non-fictional, and its reflection in narratives of artistic literature in a synchronic and diachronic perspective. The material of oral non-fictional and fictional literature was investigated, outside the classical folkloristic framework of the perception of the phenomenon of literatura as a genre- and poetologically defined discourse. The research included transethnic influences and interpenetrations given by the same cultural matrix of Adrianism, as a dialogical culture whose fundamental principle is humor. Based on the written and systematized material, a systematic analysis, valorization and interpretation of the texts was carried out from various aspects: literary, linguistic, ethnological and cultural anthropological, comparative and gender, and the research included various types of interpretation in the fields of: stylistics, narratology, literary theory, dialectology, lexicology / lexicography, semiotics, rhetoric, ethnography and cultural anthropology.
