Historiographic Contributions to the Modern History of Dalmatia (HIPRIL)

Project goal:

The aforementioned project is aligned with the strategic scientific goals of the current Development Strategy of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Split (from 2021 to 2025) in all strategic area goals. We emphasize that this ambitious two-year program, which envisages the publication of as many as six books, encourages "interdisciplinary research of the Adriatic-Mediterranean cultural and historical heritage with the aim of preserving, valorizing and popularizing the Croatian language, history, cultural heritage and Mediterranean studies in the European context" (5.2.2.). All proposed books can be used as basic and supplementary literature, thus fulfilling the goal of research in the field of lifelong learning and professional development (5.2.3.). Furthermore, by publishing these titles, "the scientific position of the Faculty in the Croatian and European research space is strengthened" (5.2.4.). Since the doctoral student Frane Bilić is also included in the project, the postgraduate doctoral study is improved (5.2.5.). Finally, two of the planned six books are to be published in co-publishing with our Department of History, thus encouraging the development of the Faculty's publishing activities. (5.2.6.)
