Project goals: This project has two goals: (1) to contribute to new knowledge in the field of fundamental understanding of the psyche, soul and to contribute to the understanding of the development of the history of psychology at a scientific level, (2) to apply modern digital humanistic methods and new technologies through an interdisciplinary approach in the research of written heritage and, on the basis of this project, to establish numerous further project-based interdisciplinary research of cultural heritage and ultimately to enable the application and development of digital humanities and new technologies in the social and humanistic sciences. In such a digitized corpus, all terms and notes that can be connected to the field of psychology will be specifically investigated using digital tools and an interdisciplinary approach, and in this way, new knowledge will be gained about the context in which Marulić interpreted and interpreted the term psychology in his famous work Psychology, on the Nature of the Human Soul (1510-1517), as well as all terms that can be connected to the field of psychology.
